

Drivers: The race to the bottom




Balance of Trade with China




Yen and Euro vs. \$ for 2003

Industry Specific Drivers: Raw materials & Magnets








There is oil in the Middle East. There are rare earths in China. We must take full advantage of this resource.






Shift in the source of raw materials

Technical Support Survey

 - -Traditional: 5/5
 - Non-traditional
 - Distributors: 1/5 first try, 2/4 second try
 - Traders: 2/5 first try, 0/3 second try
 - Consultants: 3/3
